Antennas and towers don't like 230+ km/h winds very much. Sounds like my radios & amplifiers are water damaged as well. I won't know until I return to Saipan how bad things are. Saipan airport is currently closed so I might be spending longer in China than I had planned.

I will rebuild with even bigger Yagi's in the near future. It will probably take 4-6 months for **KH0/KC0W** & **KHOW** to once again have a competitive signals on the bands. In the meantime I will concentrate on operating POTA from Saipan's numerous parks.

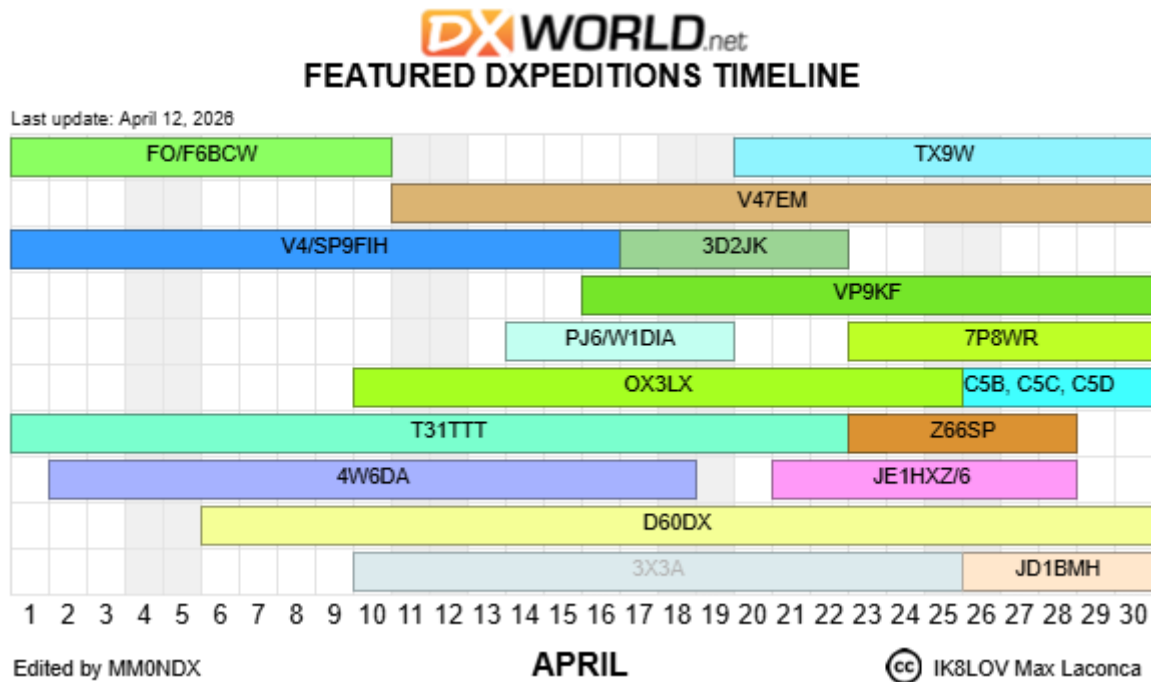


9T0MD Democratic Republic of Congo -update

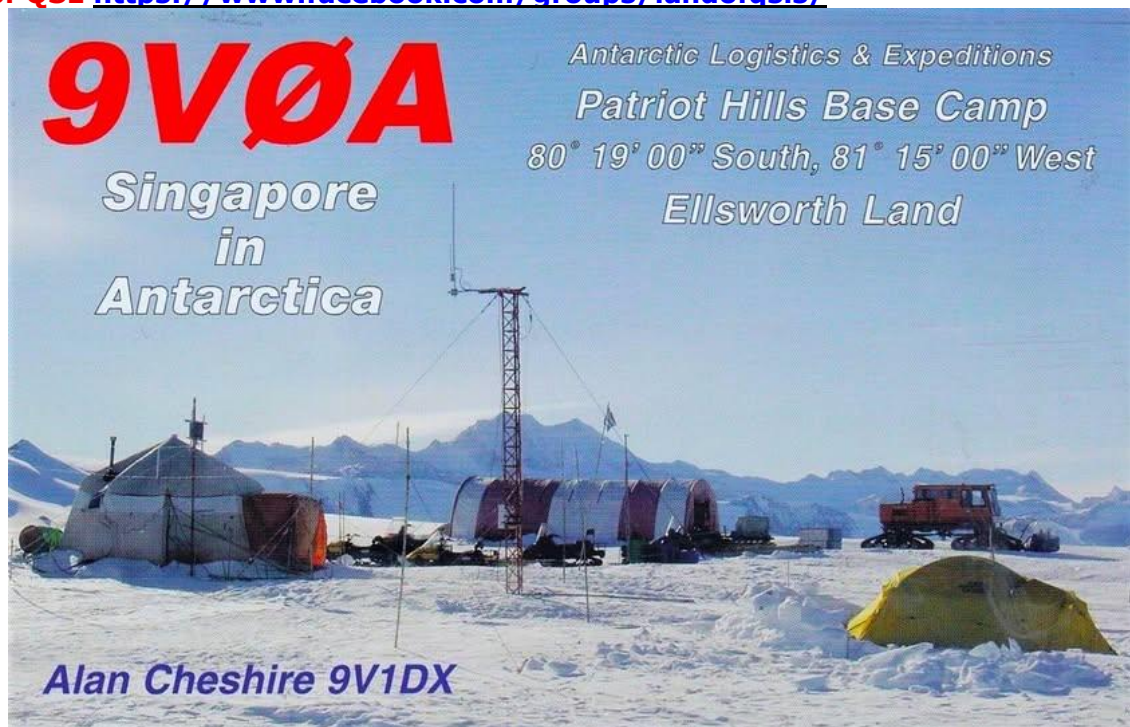

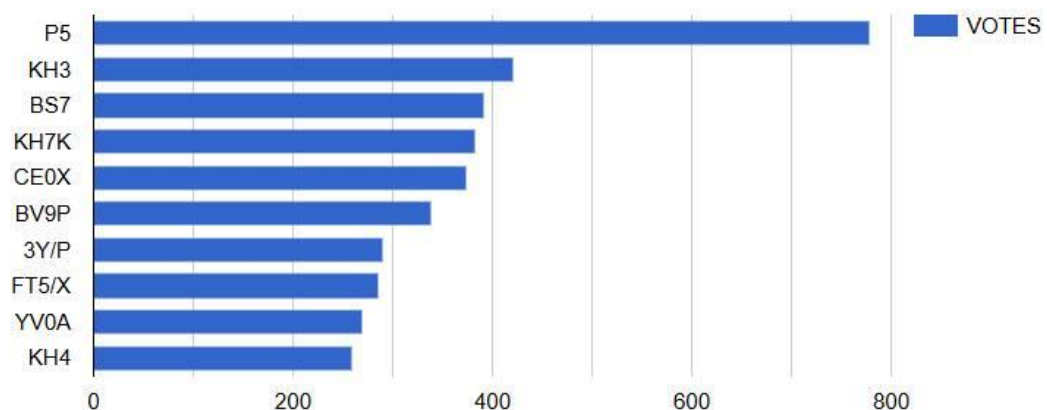

"CW and SSB remain my main focus", he says, with FT8 as "just a tool for those difficult moments when propagation doesn't cooperate". More information is expected in due course. This IOTA group was activated only once, by HK3JJH/4 back in 2002.

We recently ran a quick survey to see which DXCC entity / entities – regardless of mode – you still need. It could be you needed 1 or 10 of the current top 10 most wanted DXCC as per Club Log global data. The poll has now ended, and with nearly 4000 votes in total, here is the final table showing most wanted DXCC entities you need.
